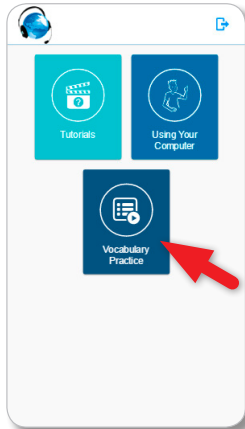


Burlington Vocabulary Practice User Guide

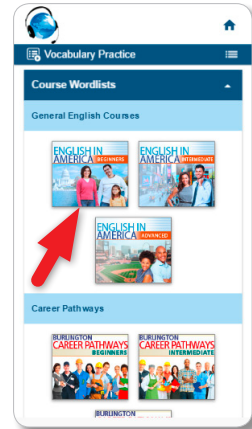
1 Once you've logged into BurlingtonEnglish, tap "Vocabulary Practice".



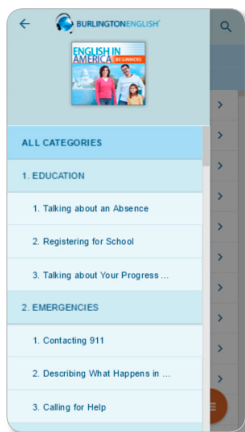
2 Tap the view icon (☰) to switch between list view or thumbnail view.



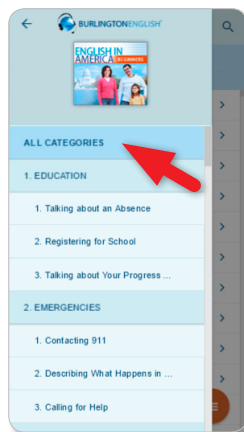
3 Choose a course to enter the Wordlist.



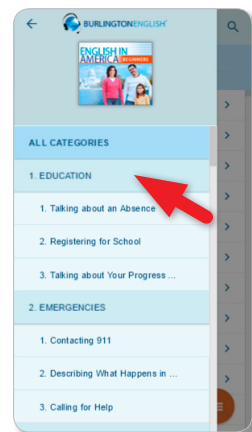
4 A list of the modules and situations, or categories, from the course appears on the left side of the screen.



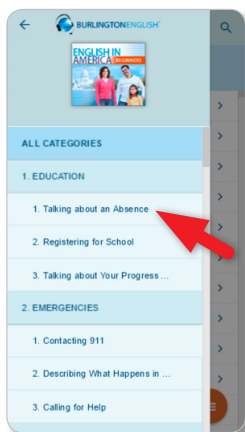
5 "All Categories" offers all the vocabulary words in the course.



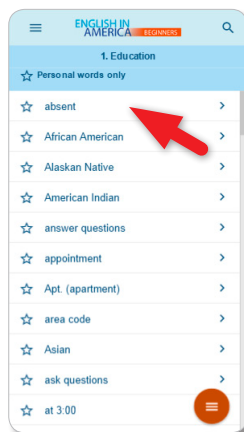
6 Tap the name of a module or category to view all the vocabulary words in a specific module or category.



7 Tap a situation to view the vocabulary words in that situation.



8 Tap a word to see it with its translation.



9 Tap the play button to hear it.



10 There is also an example sentence with the word used in context. Tap the play button to hear the example sentence.



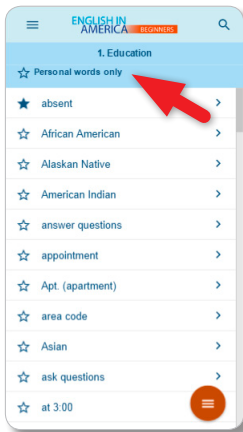
11 On the word screen, you can navigate between the words by tapping the arrows.



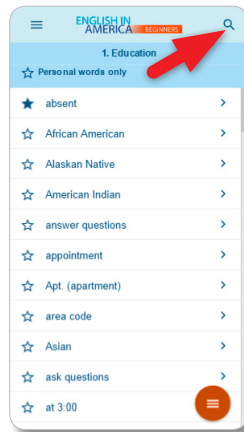
12 To add a word to your personal wordlist, tap the star (☆), either on the wordlist screen or on the word screen.



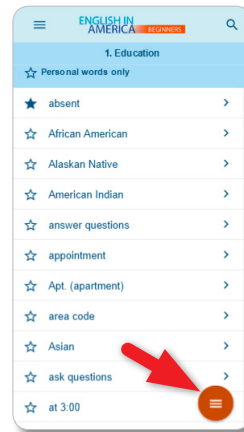
13 Tap "Personal words only" to see all the words in your personal wordlist.



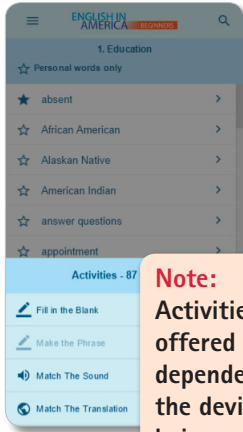
14 Use the search icon (🔍) at the top right of the screen to find a specific word quickly.



15 Tap the activities icon (☰) to access activities.

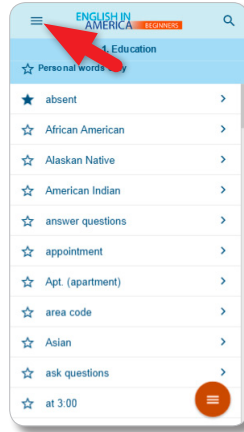


16 Activities include matching sounds to words, matching translations to words and filling in the blanks in a sentence.



Note: Activities offered are dependent on the device being used.

17 To go back to the list of modules and situations, tap the icon at the top left of the screen.



18 Tap the arrow at the top left of the screen to return to the Vocabulary Practice menu.
